- **Top Four At-Risk Indicators:**

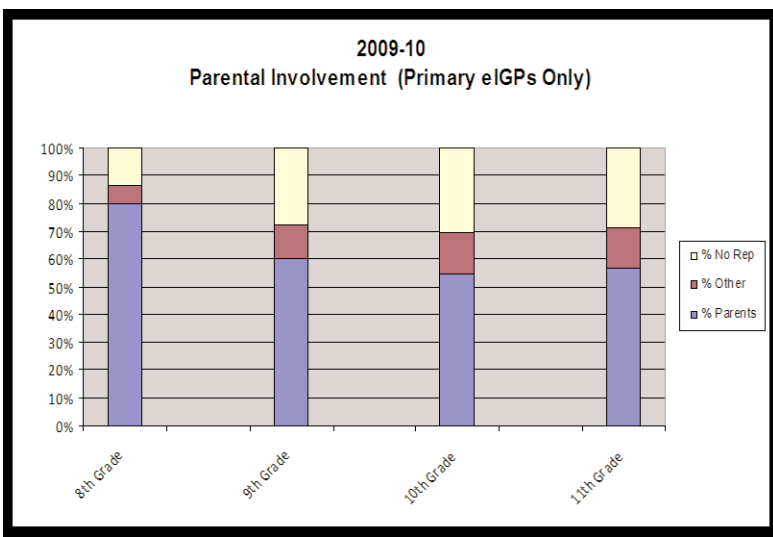
- 1) Absenteeism      3) Suspensions
- 2) Discipline      4) Below Grade Level Credits

- 80%, or 218,713, of South Carolina students in grades 8 through 12 possess at least one indicator showing they are at-risk of not advancing or dropping out.

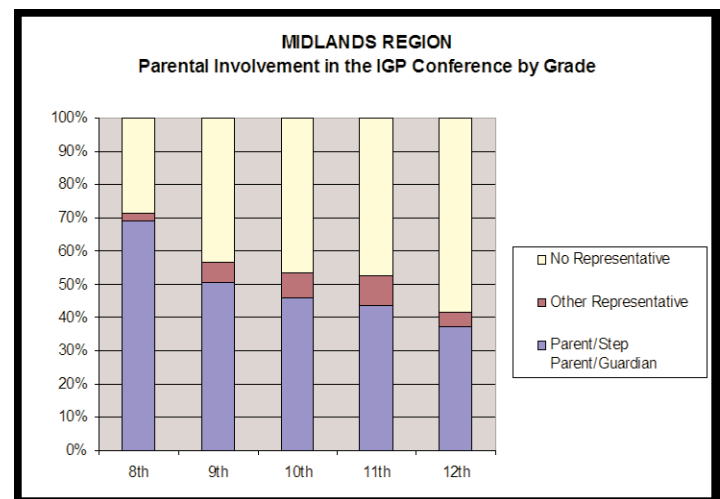


## INDIVIDUAL GRADUATION PLANS

- 79.48% of Midlands students completed an Individual Graduation Plan (IGP) during 2009-2010.
- The Midlands Region is the second highest region in completing IGP.
- Parental involvement in the IGP process is below the state average.



Statewide Involvement in the IGP Conference by Grade 2009-2010

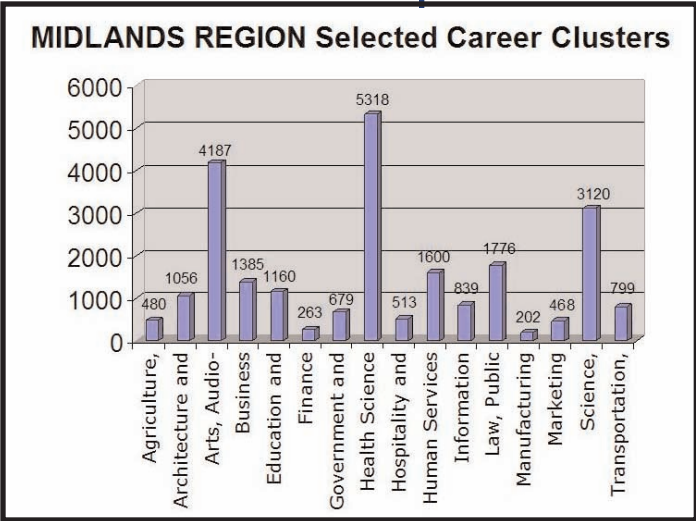


Midlands Region Involvement in the IGP Conference by Grade 2009-2010

### CAREER CLUSTERS

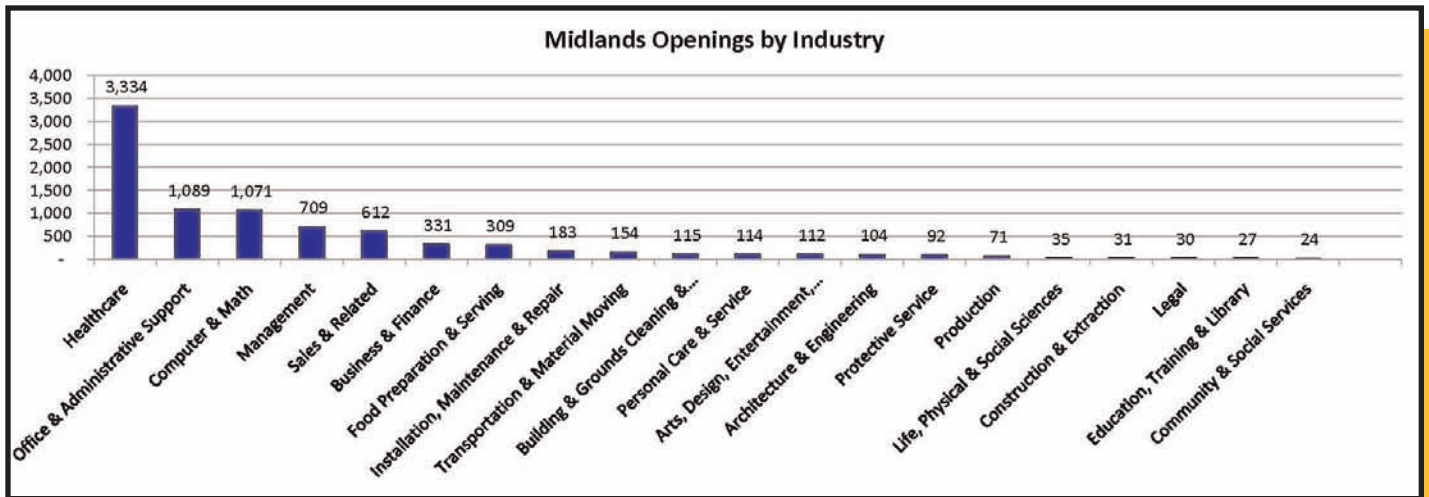
- The top three clusters selected by Midlands students are:
