About twelve interns will be selected engage with our visitors by presenting activities to our guests, as well as team with our educators at off-site locations to offer activities. The MAP interns will also participate in an NSF-supported STEM Teens project with interns working in other sites (including the Riverbanks Zoo, the Virginia Aquarium, and three museums in the United Kingdom).

**Work Schedule/Conditions:** Schedule of about 15 to 20 hours per week that includes weekends (mostly in shifts of four- or five-hours a day). This position is on site, as well as at school and community sites. Position may require some lifting and carrying program kits and other material.

- Assist education team members with floor programs delivered to EdVenture's visitors.
- Ensure that all programs are of the highest quality and meet the museum's mission and education goals.
- Present programs to young guests, as well as outreach programs.
- Represent EdVenture in a professional manner when interacting with visitors and report safety and exhibit issues to appropriate staff as necessary.
- Participate in special activities and other projects as needed and perform related duties as assigned.
